# **Empowering rural stakeholders**



PREPARE initiated jointly with SWG (Standing Working Group for Rural Development in the Western Balkans) an ambitious multi-country event entitled "Empowering rural stakeholders: Mainstreaming participation of stakeholders in development and implementation of agriculture and rural development policies in the Western Balkans and Turkey", held in early April 2014. The European Commission took over the initiative, implementing it as

a TAIEX event but structured in the way of PREPARE Gatherings, with traveling workshops and conferences in Serbia, Montenegro and the Former Jugoslav Republic of Macedonia. More about the event here.

# Rural Network of Bosnia and Herzegovina established



Cooperation between PREPARE and ELARD (European Leader Association for Rural Development) has achieved a significant outcome in Bosnia and Herzegovina. 15 non-governmental organisations gathered on 25 April 2014 in Sarajevo and established the Rural Network of Bosnia and Herzegovina. Present

were representatives from all three Ethnicities and their administration, from the EC delegation, and from the rural networks in neighbouring Balkan countries. PREPARE has played an active role in the country for the last few years: with ELARD's support, we held our annual Gathering in Bosnia and Herzegovina in September 2013, with traveling workshops to different parts of the country. Serbian, Croatian and Slovenian Rural Networks, all three PREPARE partners, supported the networking process in Bosnia and Herzegovina through bilateral cooperation activities, supported by C.S. Mott Foundation.

### **Lithuanian Rural Parliament**



Lithuanian Rural Community Union, a PREPARE partner, held its first Lithuanian Rural Parliament in April. About 100 participants, representing rural areas and different sectors throughout Lithuania, gathered for one day and concluded the event with a Resolution which has been sent to all important decision-makers in the country. Representatives from PREPARE took part at the event "Communicating Rural Development", organized by ENRD (European Network for Rural Development) in March in Lithuania.
