Survey on the State of Play of CCLD

ELARD prepared a short survey aiming at mapping the state of play of CLLD. The main purpose of this survey was to provide a short insight into the policy-making process across the Member States. It focuses on the scope and preconditions for promoting the CLLD approach by means of the European Agricultural Fund for Rural Development. Particular attention has been paid to the proportion of the management costs on the CLLD allocation. Results of the survey are available here.

e-Skills: Commission launched new campaign

Demand for jobs requiring digital skills is growing rapidly - and likely to create a skills shortage that may leave up to one million positions vacant by 2020 in Europe. The Commission has identified ICT as one of three employment growth areas and to raise awareness on e-skills the Commission launched in Athens the "e-Skills for Jobs" campaign together with the Hellenic Presidency of the EU's Council of Ministers. During the autumn of 2011 ELARD piloted a new kind of initiative that aims to offer ELARD member LAGs an opportunity for reciprocal, international staff exchange. The purpose of the program is to promote the formation and training of the participants as well as the exchange of experiences, know-how and new ideas between the European LAGs. Due to excessive amount of applications received shortly after the deadline for 4th edition of ELARD's LAG Staff Exchange Program, ELARD decided to extend the submission period so the Call for applications will be closed on 31 May 2014. The aims of "Europe for Citizens" programme are: 1. To contribute to citizens' understanding of the EU, its history and diversity; 2. To foster European citizenship and to improve conditions for civic and democratic participation at EU level; 3. To raise awareness of remembrance, common history and values; 4. To encourage democratic participation of citizens at EU level, by developing citizens' understanding of the EU policy making-process and, by promoting opportunities for societal and intercultural engagement and volunteering at EU level.
