#### **Structured Dialogue on European Structure and Investment Funds**

Goran Soster (PREPARE) participated at the first expert meeting within the Structured Dialogue on European Structure and Investment Funds, 12. November in Brussels (see Agenda). Participants discussed the situation about the State of Play on Partnership Agreements (DG Regio), Report on the Partnership Principle and Multi-level Governance (Committee of the Regions), ESF Operational Programmes (DG Employment), Survey on Implementation of Partnership, 6th Cohesion Report (DG Regio), Youth Employment Initiative (DG Employment), and CLLD – Community Led Local Development (DG Agri and DG Mare). Representatives of European Commission still did not present the general overview of CLLD in EU-28.

Around 50 participants coming from 16 different countries, many of them below 35, discovered what rural sustainability means in such a remote alpine region. Hosted and guided by Savoie Vivante - a very dynamic local development organisation - participants discussed on the topics of local food chains, youth, civic dialogue and herbs. Participants enthusiastically contributed to discussions and commonly developed ideas for a "follow up". The great diversity of backgrounds - many participants came from the South East Europe, Serbia, Macedonia, but also Ukraine through the PREPARE or Slow Food movement's context, Estonia, Sweden - made it a very inspiring and motivating experience. #### First European Rural Startup Platform (FERSP)

The First European Rural Startup Platform (FERSP) is an EU-level initiative launched in May 2014 by experts with expertise on rural entrepreneurship, rural development (RD) policy formulation and agribusiness in various EU Member States. FERSP's primary objective is to boost rural entrepreneurship via the harmonised application of public and private fi nancial instruments. FERSP is also an informal network of stakeholders sharing the view that rural startups should be better highlighted and mainstreamed both in the relevant policy dialogue and in the startup ecosystem. #### Anders WALL Award 2014/2015

The Anders Wall Award is a prize granted to private individuals who have made a special contribution to the rural environment within the European Union. This award is intended to recognize private estates that use quality instruments and management practices which contribute to the improvement of the quality of the environment, with importance at local, national and European levels by: Preserving and enhancing the landscape; Providing biodiversity; Preserving the countryside's cultural heritage; Contributing to sustainable economic local development. #### Schweighofer Prize - Innovation Award for the European Forest Based Sector

The Schweighofer Prize is donated by the Austrian Schweighofer family, who has been engaged in the European woodworking industry for generations. The Schweighofer Prize awards innovative ideas, technologies, products and services in order to strengthen the competitiveness of the European Forest Based Sector. All natural persons or groups of individuals as well as organisations are eligible to participate. The applicants have to fulfil all conditions in form and content. The most important requirement is the obvious benefit for the European Forest Based Sector. The registration starts on 1st November 2014 and closes on 2nd February 2015. More ...

### **INVOLEN - Intergenerational Learning for Nature Conservation Volunteers**

INVOLEN is an innovative project promoting intergenerational learning through game-based learning, targeting nature conservation volunteers in 5 European countries (Italy, Greece, France, Hungary and Slovenia). INVOLEN brings together two different age groups, adolescents and senior citizens and encourages their participation in voluntary activities for the protection and preservation of the European ecological heritage, focusing on NATURA 2000 sites.
