Main challenge

 DREAM TO LEAVE - Migration of large numbers of rural youth to the cities (due to lack of unempolyment, infrastructure, educational and training opportunities etc)

What is needed?

- Developing good infrastructure and positive image of rural life
- Strengthening the voice of young people -they have to get possibility to speak and their ideas must be considered
- Offering activities and support that young people can stay connected with their home village for a longer term

- Change the way of thinking (early start on family level etc)
- Empowering youth through selfesteem raising and business skills teaching
- Importance of teamwork on local level (different generations etc)
- Opportunity to enhance social networking

National level

- Umbrella organisation for rural development and for youth can apply for project money and have activities on local level but youth by themselves should implement it
- Lobby work on every level
- Encourage youth to establish NGO-s and guide them
- Special foundation for youth activities from state

International level

- More cooperation between south and north, west and east
- Youth exchange programmes wider view of different cultures (you find yourself while seeing others)
- At the PREPARE gatherings always have the thematic working group on rural youth - to have youngsters in each countries delegation (age 18-25)
