A. Actual RD policy in WB

Situation in WB rural areas:

- ... Economic decline, depopulation, rural poverty, cultural degradation
- Agriculture only partially developed
 - deficiencies in mechanisation, technology, knowledge, market integration, dual structues
- Environment less degraded by agriculture, but some serious problems in intensive regions, fallow land
- The rural policy in WB still mostly income and productionistic oriented. Sector approach.
 - Rural development policy "in development"
 - Connected mostly with EU harmonisation...
 - Rural areas often in development status...
- Serious demand for public actions, for active and efficient rural development policy! PREPARE Gathering 2011





B. Future of EU RD policy

CAP new reform wave (2013-2020)

- New CAP (budget) argumentation:
 - Public goods:
 - Food security, environmental protection, territorial balance
 - CAP funding
 - How to keep the resources...
- Direct payments 1.Pillar
 - equalising, restructuring (and greening?)
- End of traditional market price policy
 - Only as safety net, no answer on price volatility?
- New dimensions of RD policy
 - LESS AMBITIOUS CHANGES....





B. Future of EU RD policy

RD (reform) issues and EC proposal

- How to bring new challenges into policy
 - EC new issues: climate change, water management, biodiversity, risk management
- How to adopt policy to the need of NMS?
 - production orientation, less environment focusing, rural poverty?
 - EC: some awarennes (small farm isue,...)
- The conceptual crash with cohesion policy?
 - Rural development in cohesion countries overlapping structures and instruments
 - EC: Again stronger coherence with other policies
- Key: How much for RD policy and to whom what?
 - EC: New distributional criteria for funding (less for NMS, compensation for OMS?)

B. Future of EU RD policy

Comments

- The golden enthusiastic years of RD are over,
 - ...not acquiring anymore on the importance
 - Problems to keep the RD budget!
- Stabilisation against innovations and adoption to the new needs:
 - NMS, poverty, climate change....
 - ... administrative approach...
- to strong EU nucleus view(Berlin-Brussels-Paris),...
 - ... sorry, EU is very diversified
- RD is changing, but STAYING AND SURVIVING, valid and important for WBc!
- What could bring new RD (theory and practice) to WBc?





C. SWOT: RD for WBc (+)

Strenghts

- More targeted and tailored approach and new concept for solving domestic problems.
 - Implementation of policy cycle process.
 - More efficient policy.
- Donor foundation.

Opportunities

- Modernisation of domestic administration.
- Support for sustainable development.
- Local potentials used.
- Resources improved.
- Economic and social cohesion...





C. SWOT RD for WBc (-)

Weaknesses

- Less funding before the accession.
- Less acceptable by stakeholders.
 - Financing problems. Human resources deficiencies.
- Other national priorities.
- "Reformlution" for policy makers and administration.
- ..and old and new EU RD approach not completely appropriated for WB
 - other focus and priorities (policy for rich rural regions)
 - small farmers, rural poverty,... problems not touched
 - administration demanding and complex.





C. SWOT RD for WBc (-)

Threats

- Country institutions not prepared.
 - Bad and weak management (at all level)
- Potential beneficiary not capable to take their obligations (f.i. financial contributions, environmental standards compliance)
- Copy paste mentality in programming and implementing (also forced by EC!):
 - The not appropriate cases from other countries
 - Some SAPARD/IPARD examples already exists
- Redistribution mentality prevails
 - two elements important: funds are distributed and most to the most powerful clients
- Funds not used. Issues not improved. PREPARE Gathering 2011





D. Take home messages...

- 1. Rural development **remains** one of the main EU integration concept and opportunity for WBc.
- 2. Serious work has to be done in WBc:
 - much more attention for RD requested.
 - administration and stakeholders capacity upgrading.
 - Detailed and precise programming and implementing to the regional needs. Be original in the given frame.
- 3. EU should rethink the RD concept and practice:
 - ... the RD concept should be adopted more for the needs of newcomers,
 - Basically development policy in all sense is requested!
 - Partial approaches could lead to wrong messages and impacts.
